SJCC Booster Club representatives Marty Eberly, Tim Luc, Tom Light Jr., Steve Verock, John Lauer, and Rick Frank presented the history of and information about the organization. The following details were shared:

- The Booster Club began in 1946 to support athletics; the first fundraiser was a Stag.
- The Hall of Fame began in 1986.
- Average age of those attending Booster Club meetings is 50-70.
- Lack of attendance and duplicate fundraisers within our own system has caused a decline in funds raised.
- Several voiced a desire to have a master calendar of fundraisers throughout the school system.
- A request for funds procedure is in place but is not being followed. Only the Athletic Director can bring a request to Booster Club meetings and must have prior approval from the Superintendent/Principal.

Tim Cullen concurred that the process to request funds needs to be followed and the Athletic Department needs more structure. Tim thanked the Booster Club representatives for their dedication and hard work.
